Registration/School Information 2017-2018

ALL Tillamook Schools will have registration during the following times: August 16 and 17, from 11:00-4:00 and 5:00-7:00, and August 18, from 8:30-11:00 and 12:00-4:00. If you have any questions regarding registration or fees, please contact the individual school office.

REGISTRATION FORMS are available after August 1, 2017, online at www.tillamook.k12.or.us, School Basics, 2017-18 Registration Forms.

ALL ELEMENTARY students will register at East Elementary School. Staff from each of the elementary schools will assist with registering students. Immunizations will be available at East on Wednesday, 12:30-5, and Thursday, 11-4:00. Dental screening will be available Wednesday and Thursday between 11-3:00 and 5-7:00.

Tillamook Junior High students will register at the Junior High. Tillamook High School and Wilson River School students will register at Tillamook High School. Please see additional individual school information below.

GENERAL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

New Students

Parents enrolling students for the first time in Tillamook Schools are required to bring proof of birth date (birth certificate or hospital record), current immunization information, phone numbers of people to contact in case of an emergency, and name/address of previous school. Parents may access enrollment paperwork before registration dates through the district website at www.tillamook.k12.or.us, School Basics, 2017-18 Registration Forms. If available, please bring proof of current physical examination. Parent photo identification will be required at registration. Parents will receive school information and pay fees at the time of registration. Money may also be deposited to student lunch accounts.

Returning Students

Tillamook School District #9 registers all students, every year. Parents with students returning to Tillamook Schools are required to come in and update records, get school information, pay fees and deposit money in student lunch accounts. Basic registration forms are available on the TSD9 website, www.tillamook.k12.or.us, School Basics, 2017-18 Registration Forms. Parent photo identification may be required. Checks may be made out when you are actually registering in case an additional fee is required.

SCHOOL INFORMATION

Liberty Elementary School (503-842-7501), Grades K-1

Registration location: East Elementary School. **Kindergarten students who pre-registered in May do not need to register again.** Parents of new kindergarten students **must** bring proof of birth date (birth certificate, hospital record) and current immunization records. Every student must register every year. Please bring updated emergency contact information. Photo ID may be required. All students are required to pay a \$5 student activity fee and a \$25 school supply fee, which covers all materials except a backpack and lunch bag (optional). Parents may also make a deposit for student lunches.

South Prairie Elementary School (503-842-8401), Grades 2-3

Registration location: East Elementary School. Every student must register every year. Bring \$10 student activity fee, a \$25 school supply fee and updated emergency contact information. Photo identification may be required. Parents may also make a deposit for student lunches.

East Elementary School (503-842-7544), Grades 4-6

Every student must register every year. Bring \$10 student activity fee, a \$30 school supply fee and updated emergency contact information. Photo identification may be required. Parents may also make a deposit for student lunches.

Location: TJHS.

Tillamook High School (503-842-2566)

Location: Main Entrance @ THS.

Wilson River School (WRS) (503-842-7538)

All registration for WRS begins at Tillamook High School according to the established schedule. Wilson River School intake packets will be available during registration. All new and returning students should call 503.842.7538 to register for a mandatory orientation. Parent or guardian must attend this meeting with their student, unless the student is 18 years old.

GED / Evening Program (held at WRS) (503-842-7538)

All registration for GED / Evening Program begins at Tillamook High School according to the established schedule. GED / Evening Program intake packets will be available during registration. All new and returning students should call 503.842.7538 to set up a mandatory intake session. Parent or guardian must attend this meeting with their student, unless the student is 18 years old. Bring \$15 technology fee.
